Our place in the world. Learning for life. Inspired learners.

English

This term our key texts will be:

- Orion Lost by Andrew Chisholm
- A variety of Greek myths

Our writing will be focused on developing cohesion and a greater understanding of purpose, audience and effectiveness. We will produce writing to entertain:

- Descriptive writing
- Story writing including a flashback
- Poetry

We will also be writing to inform:

- A non-chronological report about the Greek Gods
- An incident report on the Greek Minotaur

Science

Our topic is 'Earth and Space'.

We will be learning to:

- describe the movement of the Earth and other planets relative to the sun in the solar system
- describe the movement of the moon relative to the Earth
- describe the sun, Earth and moon as approximately spherical bodies
- use the idea of the Earth's rotation to explain day and night and the apparent movement of the sun across the sky

Computing

This term we will be learning to:

- design an information app that contains multimedia pages linked together using hyperlinks.
- learn how to evaluate the usefulness of a website.
- discuss reasons for and against sharing material publicly online.
- understand the importance of online consent.
- create flowcharts of real life systems showing how steps of algorithms are linked together.
- describe the services offered by the Internet.

Maths

Our maths topics this term are:

- place Value
- addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division
- Fractions

We will continue to consolidate and extend our mental maths skills and calculation formal methods and strategies. We will be working both conceptually and procedurally.

When learning something new we encourage the children to use the CPA approach.

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures

Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations
