KS2 STEM Science Day

As part of our science and STEM focus during science week, we arranged for some of our KS2 pupils to go and visit the Ricardo Shoreham Technical centre, home to where the McLaren engines are individually put together by hand as well as enabling a sustainable future by creating **innovative services** that are at the intersection of transport, energy and environment agendas across the globe.

Our pupils had a tour of the centre and were able to see some of the engineers at work, watch the McLaren engines being made as well as the experience the sound test centre where car door closing, engines and other car comfort noises are tested.

They were also invited to design and make a wind turbine to generate electricity to a house. The children were given the blade structure and then from this created, tested and improved their design before the final test. It was great to see them trialling out their designs, making amendments, thinking of ways they could generate more energy.

The top 3 wind turbines that generated the most electricity actually generated significantly more electricity than the demonstration which has never been achieved before so well done Thakeham!
