

The Dome

Around 15 minutes after we arrived, Franklin went into the dome to look at all of the amazing things that the person talked to them about like: the space race, how you could see different planets and a galaxy in the night, at different times you could see different things at different times and the different rooms and parts of the ISS (the international space station).

The Quiz

Near the end of our trip, Franklin took a ten question quiz about different space subjects and you had to find the answers to the questions around the room in different places. When you found the answer to a question, then you would put it on your sheet, which you worked with someone else in your class.

Wonder Class's Trip to the Brighton Toy Museum

Wonder class went on a school trip to the toy museum on the 24th of October. They played with toys from the past and explored the toy museum under supervision at all times. They had lots of fun there. During the trip, Wonder looked at how Meccano was named and how it works. They looked at the history of Lego, which used to be wooden and fairly big, and they also saw the oldest toy- a spinning top that was 6,000 years old. The site was very small and very enjoyable. Of course, Wonder enjoyed the trip there and back, being on the bus. Whilst on the trip, they wrote stories about the past history of toys and fun things children used to do back in the day.

They had so many fun times. Both trips were very enjoyable for the classes and they all arrived back better than before!

How to apply

If your child's date of birth is between 1 September 2020 and 31 August 2021 it is now time to apply for their school place. You need to apply online by visiting westsussex.gov.uk/admissions

Please be aware that the email address which you provide will be shared with your preference schools and allocated school, as parents and schools increasingly communicate electronically.

If you do not have access to the internet, free access to apply for a school place is available in all West Sussex libraries.

The website provides information needed for completing your application, including details of all the schools in West Sussex, your catchment school and important information for parents. Please read it carefully before making your application.

There are some benefits to applying online and we strongly advise all parents to do so. However, if you really can't access the internet you can obtain a paper form by calling 03330 142 903.

Please note, you must provide a valid email address with your application in order to receive the outcome of your school offer.

Admissions – key dates Monday 7 October 2024

Online applications open.

You must provide an email address to apply. You can apply online for your child's school place by visiting westsussex.gov.uk/admissions.

Schools will have their prospectuses available and will have arranged open events.

Wednesday 15 January 2025

National closing date for starting school applications.

You must submit your completed application by this date. Failure to do so will affect the priority attached to your application.

Wednesday 16 April 2025

National offer day.

Applicants will be notified which school their child is offered by email, where an email address is supplied.

You must apply on time

It is very important that you apply before the closing date of Wednesday 15 January 2025.

If your application is received after the closing date of **Wednesday 15 January 2025** your chance of securing a place at one of your preference schools could be seriously affected.

Applications received after the closing date of Wednesday 15 January 2025 are late applications and will only be considered after all those that were received on time.

It is your responsibility as a parent to ensure that your application is received by the Pupil Admission Team on time.



Your preferences

We advise all parents to think very carefully about their three preferences and to use them wisely.

School places are allocated according to the published oversubscription criteria for that school. This can include criteria such as whether you live in the catchment area, whether there are siblings already at the school and the distance you live from the school.

Please be realistic in your preferences. You have a higher priority for local schools. If you chose an oversubscribed school, the further away you live the less likely you are to be offered a place.

Please note that personal circumstances, such as child care arrangements, are not part of the oversubscription criteria for any school and will not be taken into consideration.

Finally, we always advise parents to include their catchment school as one of their three preferences.

Making an online application

To make an application using the online system you will need:

- · an email address; and
- create an account on Parent Portal if you do not already have an account.

Your Username will be your email address.

Your password must adhere to the following rules. It must:

- · be at least 8 characters long;
- have at least one character that is UPPERCASE:
- have at least one character that is lowercase;
- have at least one special character (such as: *! \$); and
- have at least one number.


