This term our key texts will be:

Our maths topics this term are:

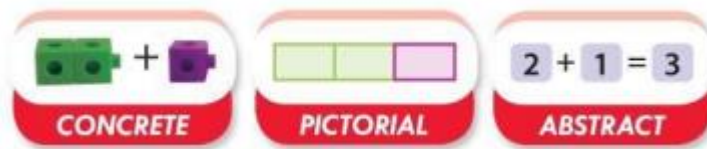
- **Money**

We will be developing their money knowledge by using lots of hands-on methods. We will then cover fractions as well as looking at different ways of measurement. When learning something new, we encourage the children to use the CPA approach:

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures

Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations

Other highlights

Geography: We will looking at Season and daily weather patterns .
