‘Dragons and
Dinosaurs’



English

This term our key texts will be:

- Sir Scallywag and the Deadly Dragon Poo
- The Dinosaur that Pooped the Planet

Early on, we will be focusing on what you need to form a sentence and making sure we are using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be learning to retell the stories using actions and expression. The children will create their own stories about Barron Greedyguts and Sir Scallywag. Finally, we will be researching and creating a dinosaur fact file. We will also have weekly phonics and handwriting lessons.

We will produce writing in the following genres:

- Narrative
- Non- chronological report

Science

We will be looking at Materials

We will be investigating different materials, their uses and then experimenting which types would be suitable to make an umbrella.

Computing

This term we will be focusing on:

- Learning to identify a variety of technology features.
- To use a digital device to take a photograph.
- Learning how to stay safe online.

This term is all about Being Me and understanding the places we feel safe, being part of our school and creating some class rules!

Maths

Our maths topics this term are:

- Place Value (Year 1 and 2)
- Addition and Subtraction (Year 1 and 2)
- Shape (Year 1 and 2)

We will be learning about number and counting accurately, ensuring we have strong understanding of place value and more or less. We will then continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills by using mental and written methods of calculation supported by resources such as Numicon, dienes blocks and tens frames. This will then move on to geometry, specifically 2D and 3D shapes, naming and discussing their properties.

When learning something new we encourage the children to use the CPA approach.

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations



Other highlights

History: In History we will be looking at Mary Anning, talking about her big discovery, dinosaur fossils..

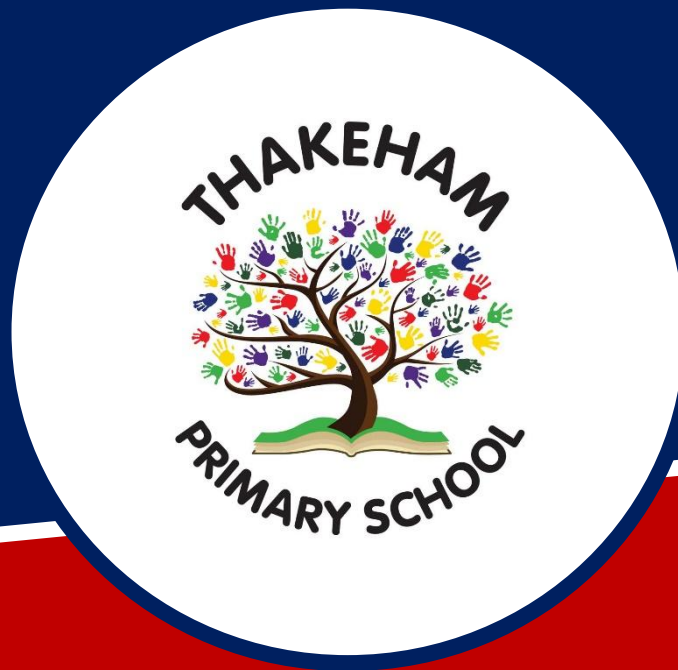
Geography: This term we will be learning about, our local area and how to use a map.
