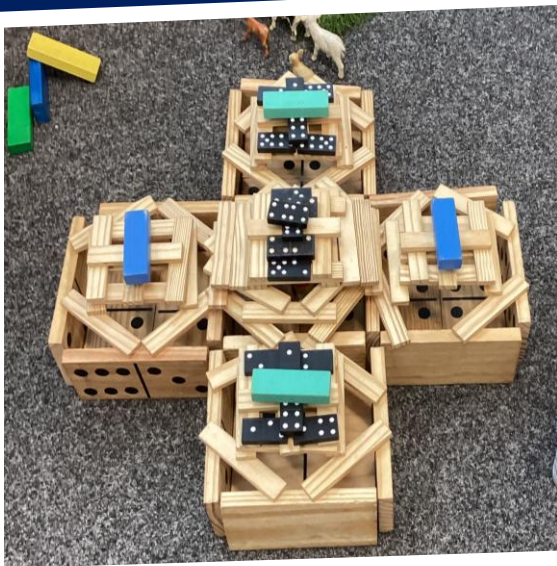

English

This term our key texts will be:

- The Great Explorer
- Lost and Found

This term we will be continuing to focus on what is needed to form a sentence and making sure we are using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces. We will be learning to write instructions and a setting description. The children will also write a diary entry looking at Captain Scott's Adventures. We will also have weekly phonics and handwriting lessons.

We will produce writing in the following genres:

- Setting description
- Diary entry
- Narrative
- Instructional writing

Science

We will be looking at Weather and Seasons:

We will be looking at the 4 seasons and the different types of weather, explaining the changes we see in the different seasons and know that the length of the day changes in the different seasons.

PE

PSHE

This term is all about Healthy and Wellbeing.

We will be discussing and understanding emotions, identifying our strengths and qualities, learning about the importance of sleep and relaxation for our wellbeing and thinking about the people who help to keep us healthy.

Maths

Our maths topics this term are:

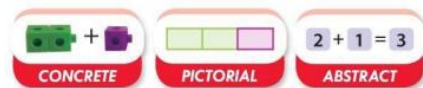
- Multiplication and Division (Year 1 and 2)
- Addition and Subtraction (Year 1 and 2)
- Length and Height (Year 1 and 2)

We will continue to develop our addition and subtraction skills by using mental and written methods of calculation supported by resources such as numicon, dienes blocks and tens frames. This will then move on to multiplication and division continuing to use practical resources to support. Next, we will introduce different units of measure.

When learning something new we encourage the children to use the CPA approach.

Concrete - using objects and equipment

Pictorial - represent their thinking using pictures Abstract - using numbers and symbols to solve calculations



Other highlights

History: In History we will be looking at Captain Scott, talking about his journey to Antarctica.

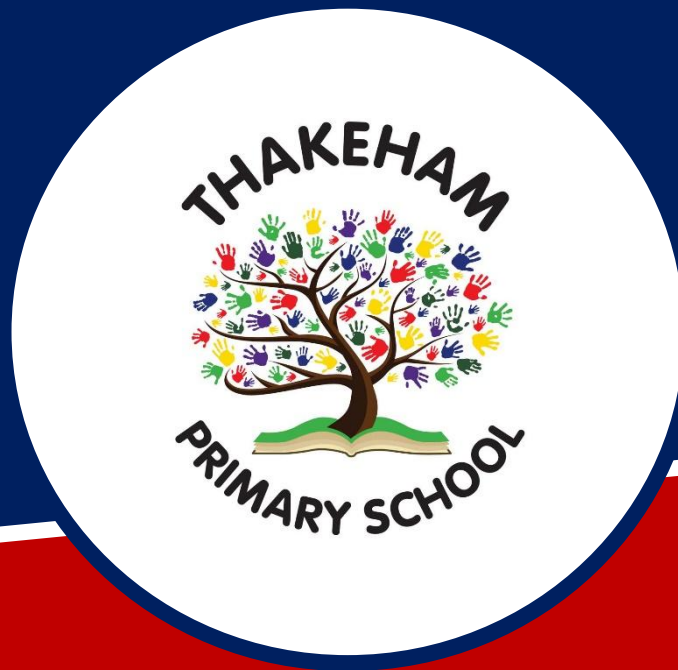
Geography: This term we will be learning about the continents and oceans and looking at the climate in Antarctica.
