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Awards this Fortnight




This year, we have moved away from using the Super Learning Hero Awards because they do not

Inclusion Newsletter



As Dyscalculia day was recently celebrated this week, I just wanted to raise it's profile and awareness once again.

Dyscalculia is a learning disability that makes it hard to understand, learn, or use numbers and math. It's also known as a mathematics learning disability. Symptoms of dyscalculia include:

•Difficulty with counting, adding, subtracting, multiplying, and dividing

- •Difficulty with money management, such as making change or calculating a tip
- •Difficulty in calculating time or distances
- •Difficulty in spotting patterns with numbers

•High levels of anxiety

In school we are working on the early identification and support for our pupils who may show signs of dyscalculia. If you have any questions or concerns about your own child and their math knowledge/ skills, please feel free to speak to your class teacher or myself.


